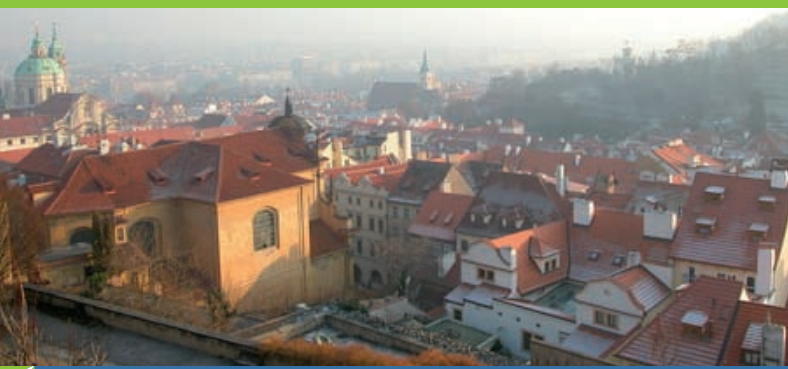

INTRODUCTION

Central Europe towards Sustainable Building Prague 2013 (CESB13) event is a part of 2013 international conferences series convened under auspices of the four international organizations iiSBE, CIB, UNEP-SBCI and FIDIC.

CESB13 will be the third conference in a row held on the actual topic of sustainable building. The previous CESB07 and CESB10 were very successful, both hosting over 200 delegates sharing knowledge from more than 30 countries.

Local organizers are Czech Sustainable Building Society (iiSBE Czech) and three institutes of the Czech Technical University in Prague: Sustainable Building Centre at Faculty of Civil Engineering, Klokner Institute and University Centre for Energy Efficient Buildings.

We are looking forward meeting you in historical Prague and discussing problems of Sustainable Building and Refurbishment for next Generation.

Implementation of sustainable building principles into education at different stages – secondary schools, universities, lifetime education, public awareness and dissemination

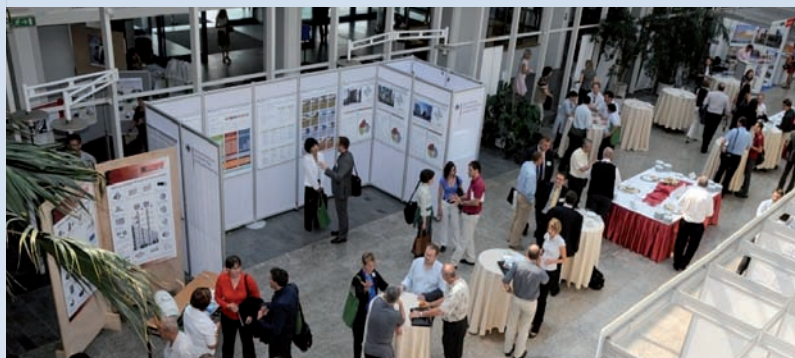
SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS

Abstracts of 150–250 words in English shall be registered into conference electronic system accessible at the website www.cesb.cz until 15th September 2012. Information on the acceptance of abstracts and on the preparation of full papers will be given by 15th November 2012. Two-steps review process will be applied.

All papers accepted by the Scientific Committee and presented at the Conference in oral or poster form will be published in printed book of proceedings. As with the CESB10 proceedings, inclusion in Thompson Reuters database is expected.

Extended papers will be published on USB drive or made available for download at the Conference website. Selected papers can be used for further publication by mutual agreement with the author.

All speeches and posters will be presented in English.

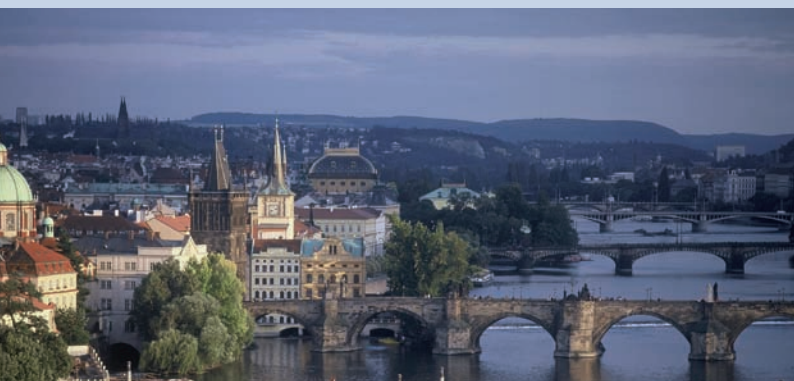
